Changing our name is not a decision we take lightly. We're proud of ElderHealth Northwest and the work we've accomplished over the last 30 years. As a leader in providing community-based care options for frail elders, adults with disabilities and their families, we've helped thousands of people live healthier and fuller lives.

You'll find younger adults in our adult day health centers, memory care homes, mental health, care consultation and home care programs. Indeed, only our volunteer companionship program exclusively serves older adults.

Community members tell us how grateful they are for the care we provide, and how enriching it is to the lives of our participants and their families. Often we hear how important our services were in our participants' final years.

We chose the name Full Life because it embodies the essence of our services and embraces the age range of participants in our programs, half of whom are not elders.
